Proposals for Discussion & Voting

a. Event Restrictions Transgression Sanctions

Given repeated incidents at events that could potentially place the future use of venues in jeopardy, it is proposed:

- i. All host clubs to report any event transgressions, however serious, to the League officials.
- ii. Transgression attributable to an **individual**:

Athlete warning and club notification (fixture)

iii. Serious transgression attributable to an **individual**:

Athlete disqualification and club notification (fixture)

iv. Repeated serious transgression attributable to an **individual/club**: Athlete/cub ban (season/permanent)

b. Club Volunteer Marshals Requirement

Some clubs are failing meet the mandatory requirement to supply volunteer marshals as clearly detailed on the OXL Affiliation/Entry Form.

The League cannot be expected to continue without the full co-operation of all its member clubs.

d. Senior Divisions Restructure

- ii. Option 2:
 - 1. Increase Divisions 1 and 2 to 10 teams
 - 2. If dropouts or no team results recorded team(s) automatically demoted
- iii. Option 3:
 - 1. Ladies Teams of 5 to help reduce number of teams in Division 3
